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How is the Training Delivered?





Interactive Webinar

This is the online alternative to our 1-day training events, which were hugely popular across Scotland. These are two interactive webinars, delivered one week apart. Attendees receive a delegate pack and resource pack.

Bitesize Videos

This unique video training programme is flexible for you to accesslearning on the go. The programme runs for 4 weeks. Eachweek a new bitesize video is released, for you to watch when convenient. The videos explain key concepts and pointers to resources. Join an optional weekly online drop-in session, where you can meet the tutor and other participants to discussthat week's theme, ask questions and share ideas.





Team Intensive Workshops

Team Intensive Workshop: Bring staff from your school or cluster together (virtually) for collaborative learning. Theseworkshops can be booked for morning, afternoon or evening slots. Schoolsmight be particularly interested in arranging an in-service event.


Who is this training programme for?
